REHABILITATION OF GULISTON-PARHAR-PANJ-DUSTI ROAD

1. BASIC INFORMATION

1.1 TITLE: Rehabilitation of Guliston-Parhar-Panj-Dusti road

1.2 SECTOR: Road

1.3 LOCATION: Republic of Tajikistan

2. OBJECTIVES

2.1 OVERALL OBJECTIVES: rehabilitation of Guliston-Parhar-Panj-Dusti road, with total length of 133 km, which connects Republic of Tajikistan and Islamic Republic of Afghanistan and provides access to southern seaports.

PROJECT PURPOSE: Guliston - Parhar - Panj - Dusti road was built in 1932. This road has an important national economic meaning for the development of the country's economy. The 133-kilometer road connects the southern regions of Khatlon with the south-western regions of the country, and also connects two routes AH7 and AH66 according to the scheme of the Asian highways (ASD). In order to ensure a reliable and uninterrupted passage of vehicles along this road, it is necessary to perform its reconstruction, which involves changing all its geometric parameters to the requirements of the norms for Technical Category III, with a width of 12 m and a roadway width of 7 m.

2.2 CONTRIBUTION TO NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN: this project is included in the State Investment Program on 2016-2020

2.3 CROSS BORDER IMPACT: rehabilitation of Guliston - Parhar - Panj - Dusti road will allow transport link from Afghanistan (via Nizhniy Panj) through Parhar - Guliston - Kulyab - Khorog - Murghab and further through the Kulma pass to the People 's Republic of China by the shortest route. Thus, the route will be reduced in comparison with the direction of Dusti-Kurgan-Tube - Dangara-Guliston and then 63 km. After rehabilitation of the road, there will be an opportunity for the development of international tourism in the region, mining enterprises and energy. Will be created prerequisites for the creation of the Free Economic Zone in the border area with Afghanistan.

3. DESCRIPTION

3.1 BACKGROUND AND JUSTIFICATION: In order to implement one of the strategic goals of the country's social and economic development - the transformation of the Republic of Tajikistan into a transit country, the Republic of Tajikistan has joined a number of agreements and international conventions in the field of transport, the provisions of which provide the implementation of measures to improve the condition of international transport corridors.

The investment project "Rehabilitation of Guliston-Parhar-Panj-Dusti road" was prepared to improve the international transit corridors.


