



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
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1.0 Project Synopsis - Contract No 01-0167

Wider Objectives: To promote and develop a harmonised TRACECA Transport Corridor within the region and between the Caucuses/ Central Asia and Europe

Specific Project Objectives: To create a platform for harmonised border crossing procedures within the region. To work towards regional integration with international transport and trade practices and to promote the movement of traffic along the TRACECA corridor and to lay the foundations for convergence with EU practices.

Outputs: The following outputs will be provided:

- Institutional deliverables: IGC Coordination Development, Customs Working Groups, Institutes of Customs Brokers, Training in modern border procedures within the Working Groups;
- Technical: Border Procedures Evaluation and Database, Border Documentation Report, Harmonised Controls and Implementation Plan, Manual for Customs Officers, User Guide for transport operators and traders, Pre-Feasibility Report on Development of Common Transit Procedures;

Activities:

- Development of a Coordination Mechanism with the IGC and the National Commissions.
- Review of Previous Work and Recommendations.
- 3. Audit of Designated Border Crossings and Procedures.
- Development of Reports on Designated Documentation and Harmonisation Controls.
- 5. Establishment of Customs Working Groups and Brokers Institutes.
- 6. Training in Modern Border Procedures within the Working Groups.
- 7. Proposals for a Common Transit Procedural System.
- 8. Production of User-Guides and Manuals (Russian/English)

Target Group: The direct Beneficiary is the National TRACECA Commissions (or their equivalent) and the Inter Governmental Commission. The indirect beneficiaries will be the various border organisations, traders and transport organisations through harmonised and simplified procedures.

Inputs: Technical assistance will include 960 person-days of long-term experts, 490 person-days of short-term experts. A project office will be established in Baku within the IGC and there will be a Focal Point within the National Commissions in each country. Visits will be made to all relevant organisations and selected border crossings. Liaison will be maintained with other TRACECA projects and the other IFIs active in the region.

Assumptions:

- TRACECA National Commissions have sufficient influence to implement changes in border procedures and facilitate the work of the project;
- National Customs will be fully supportive of Customs Working Groups and allow external involvement in meetings;
- Customs Broking Institutes can be formed and established as legal entities.

2.0 Project Activities - Overview.

2.1 Introduction.

The HBCP Project made excellent progress, with the Working Groups, in the Black Sea and Caucasus Region and moderate progress in the Asia Region. It is well understood that the differential in progress is related to individual countries circumstances and not to any negative reactions or attitude towards the TRACECA Programme.

The Project Management has, for several months, been concentrating on the quality and effectiveness of the National Secretaries as they are recognised as the prime catalyst to progress and sustainability of the TRACECA Programme through the Working Groups.

The project commencement and production of the Inception Report of the Common Legal Basis for Transit Transportation Project (CLBTT) is also seen as a significant sustainability factor for both the HBCP and UPTFT Projects where the outstanding longer-term tasks can be carried forward by the CLBTT Project. This conforms to the original ToR's and planning concept of this trio of TRACECA projects.

N.B. This Monthly Report covers the two months of February and March 2003 due to the imminent production of the Second Project Progress Report in April/May 2003.

2.2 Borders Audit Database and Website.

The latest BordAudit Database process of translation into Russian comprises around 4,700 entries of standardised text and eventually both Russian, after subsequent terminology appraisal by the Customs Service and English versions will be available on the HBCP Website. However, due to the requirement of the Project to comply with the new EU EuropeAid Co-operation Office 'Visibility Guidelines' there will be a significant delay in the launching of the Project Website. The Website itself was due to be launched in March 2003 but will be delayed until April or May 2003 as the original website structure and web pages will now require rewriting.



2.3 IGC and National Secretaries.

The future clarification of the role of the TRACECA National Secretaries will be vital to the sustainability of the TRACECA and there is an urgent requirement to officially quantify what is expected from them and their activities. To this end the CLBTT Project should include in its future planning:

- Task and Function Descriptions for National Commissions
- · Task, Function and Job Descriptions for National Secretaries

There are certain expectations of a National Secretary but it requires a specific set of instructions so that everyone can understand and fulfil those expectations. This also applies to the National Commission, the TRACECA Permanent Secretariat and the IGC. Each of these entities must have Function and Job Descriptions to enable them and others to clearly understand their roles and responsibilities, to enable the evaluation of their effectiveness, to ascertain the ongoing quality of their work in terms of productivity and their impact on the sustainability of TRACECA as a Transport Corridor.

Additionally, there must be a defined Reporting System whereby TRACECA related information is exchanged and recorded in a proper manner. This will assist the decision making process for both further development of the TRACECA institution and background justification for Technical Assistance and Infrastructure Projects.

Therefore, the Function and Job Description will enhance the overall criterion, which has been stated in previous reports, for National Secretaries. This will then lead to dedicated National Secretaries who will ensure the future of TRACECA as a viable Transport Corridor and to maximise Trade Facilitation in the Region.

N.B. Currently, there are some National Secretaries who have not fully understood the fundamental concept of the Project Recommendations and the practical fulfilment of those recommendations by using the function of the Working Groups. Those concerned should return to the Project Progress and Monthly Reports where the process is explained in detail. If this is not sufficient then it can be arranged that the National Secretary concerned can attend a Working Group of another country where the process is being successfully implemented. However, this should not be required if the National Secretary is working in close cooperation with the Regional Team Leader who will act as advisor in all matters concerning Project Recommendations and Working Groups.

2.4 Working Group Terms of Reference (TFWG-ToR).

These new guidelines are still being developed in close cooperation of the TRACECA IGC, Coordination Team, the Project Experts and the legal aspects will be addressed by the CLBTT Project. It is foreseen that this can be an addition or annex to the Multilateral Agreement (MLA). There is therefore a specific requirement for the CLBTT Project to undertake this development task



2.5 Other Projects and International Funding Institutes (IFI's).

The HBCP Project remains active in its cooperation with other EU Funded Projects.

The HBCP Regional Team Leader for Asia worked in close cooperation with the Project Leader responsible for Central Asian Border Crossings in the Custom Facilities and Central Asian Road Border Crossings Project. This included a HBCP Project presentation at a Seminar in Almaty on 13-14th March 2003.

Additionally, the HBCP Regional Team Leader for Black Sea & Caucasus made a presentation of the HBCP Project at the PETrA Conference in Odessa on 18 –20th March 2003. The TRACECA National Secretary of Azerbaijan will also make a presentation on Working Groups.

The professional relationships that have been established with other funding agencies have created a system of information exchange and mutual cooperation in the important areas of Trade Facilitation.

Current relationships continue to exist with:

- World Bank
- ADB
- ESCAP
- UN ECE, WHO
- IRU
- There is continued dialogue and meetings with the World Bank in relation to cooperation on Working Groups and combined Websites.
- ADB has been very active in their seminars and have transferred the majority of their Customs and Border related Presentation Material to the HBCP Project. ADB have also asked the Project to make a presentation in Manila in April 2003.
- ESCAP have exchanged documentation and requested that the HBCP Project makes a presentation at their seminars in Baku on 27-29th of March 2003
- UNECE was visited in Geneva by the HBCP Project Regional Team Leader for Black Sea & Caucasus. This was to align the project with the latest trends in International Conventions, Frontier Controls and Documentation. Other entities visited in Geneva where WHO and IRU.

2.6 Project Future Planning.

The Project Planning will include a second Borders Harmonisation Evaluation Workshop (BHEW) in July 2003 to bring, once again, the Project Experts together with the purpose of:

- Evaluating overall Project Progress and review of 2nd Progress Report.
- Evaluating the Practical Results of the Initial Recommendations.
- Evaluating the effectiveness of the Working Groups.
- Evaluating tasks that require future inclusion into the CLBTT Project.
- Recommending Direction and Planning for the Project Final Phase.

The immediate future planning of the Project is still focused on the consolidation and implementation of Working Groups and Border Harmonisation Recommendations. The Project is working towards a Pilot Study to physically bring the Working Groups of Azerbaijan and Georgia together at their respective interfacing Border Posts.

The only significant changes in the planning of the Project are:

- A slight variance in Report Production where new EU Visibility Guidelines have been issued and require a change in Report Format.
- A gradual transfer of longer-term legal related tasks to the CLBTT Project.
- A variance in adapting to different levels of Working Group progress.
- A variance in the completion and launch of the Projects Website due to changes required to conform to new EU Visibility Guidelines.

Specific Project Objectives: To create a platform for harmonised border-crossing procedures within the region. To work towards regional integration with international transport and trade practices and to promote the movement of traffic along the TRACECA corridor and to lay the foundations for convergence with EU practices.



2.7 EU Monitoring Team.

The previous concerns of the Contractor on the completeness of the Project Monitoring, where the Project includes 13 countries but the Monitoring does not, has recently improved and the use of the 'horizontal' technique is greatly assisted by the activities of the Senior Monitor based in Tblisi.

It is hoped that the reliance on local Monitors will now give a more Regional and objective focus with the current distribution of relevant Project information, by the Senior Monitor in Tblisi, directly to them.




