Fleet Quality, a common scenario:

Registration procedure is fast and efficient
little information about the ship is gained
Survey and certification is delegated to ROs
No own information is gained by the Administration about the ship's condition
Flag State Inspection is limited to specific cases
No systematic information about fleet's condition
Who has control over the ships conditions?





PSC Statistics

For Flag States every detentions counts
For Classification Societies the 90 days rule applies

For a medium fleet size a detention rate of ~5% qualifies for Grey List, ~10% for Black List







What influence has a RO on a Flags PSC statistic?

- ROs are doing the regular statutory surveys
- ROs are issuing/endorsing the statutory certificates
- Probably a RO surveyor was the last one having surveyed the ship related to a [detainable] PSC deficiency
- ROs are doing ISM audits and certification
- Various potentially detainable deficiencies are within the scope of work of a ship's RO
