- Regulation R1.3
- National laws

Only MLC rule without accompanying guidelines because the topic is covered by the IMO STCW Convention

## **Training**

Seafarers not covered by the STCW Convention (R1.3. paragraphs 1 & 2): Minimum requirements:

- Trained and qualified to carry out their duties on board ship
- Individual course on personal safety

#### Recruitment and placement

Definition of public or private service:

Any person or institution engaged in recruiting seafarers on behalf of shipowners or placing seafarers with shipowners (Article II(1)(h))

#### Critical area

- Subject to inspection and certification
- Responsibility of shipowner

## Responsibility of the country supplying the labour:

- If public recruitment/placement services have been established:
  - procedures to protect and promote the rights of seafarers
- 2. If private recruitment/placement services are in place:
  - maintain a regulation and licence system or another regulatory method

### Recruitment and placement

Responsibility of the country supplying the labour:

The following are subject to regulation:

- private services whose primary purpose is the recruitment and placement of seafarers
- private services that recruit and place a significant number of seafarers

### Recruitment and placement

#### Obligations for private services:

#### Members shall:

- prohibit blacklisting
- prohibit charging the seafarer for the costs of obtaining employment

#### Recruitment & placement Services:

- obligation to keep a register
- obligation to check documents requested from the seafarer
- obligation of insurance

### Recruitment and placement

#### Responsibility of shipowner:

- 1. Direct recruitment of shipowner:
- 2. Recruitment via a public service (in a country party to the MLC, 2006)
- 3. Recruitment via a private service
  - operating in own country
  - ▶ in another country party to the MLC, 2006
- 4. Recruitment via a service in a country not party to the MLC, 2006
  - ► the use of such services in countries not party to the MLC, 2006 must be justified
