Methodology of Workshop

This is the last event in a series of workshops and seminars regarding the TRAS. The participating countries and institutions will all come to a final decision on the TRAS Priority Action Plan and the TRAS modus operandi (including the first RWG presidency by Turkey).

The working session will be structured interactively. Meaning, the SASEPOL team will consist of a number of experts, who will provide ad-hoc advice on issues raised. This SASEPOL expert panel will be brought into action under the guidance of the TRACECA Secretary General, Mr. Eduard Biriucov and consist of:

This panel of experts can be addressed at any given time; separate meetings can be held with members of this panel, before, during and after the working sessions. The aim is to finalise the TRAS in all aspects. In addition, a slight re-shift of the focus of the RWG will be introduced, as a "TRAS Executive Committee" with Turkey being brought forward as the desired candidate for the first presidency. The RWG meeting at the end of September, beginning of October will make the final decision on this matter and on the extension of the mandate (6 to 12 months).

The participants for this TRAS workshop are kindly requested to review the latest TRAS version and to prepare their specific comments along the methodology (and chaptering) of the TRAS itself. The working session will follow the TRAS structure (as was the case at the TRAS drafting session in Odessa in April 2011).
